Graduate School Academic Faculty Regulations

March 25, 2001
Regulations No. 1

Article 1 (Purpose)

These regulations stipulate the necessary matters concerning graduate school academic faculties in order to achieve the graduate school aims and objectives, in accordance with article 7 paragraph 2 of the Regulations of Nara Institute of Science and Technology (Regulations No. 1, 2004)

Article 2 (Academic faculty organization)

The academic faculty shall be organized to appropriately and flexibly respond to the developments of academic research in the areas of frontier science and technology, while being able to develop educational research.

Article 3 (Divisions)

Graduate school academic faculties shall be divided into the following divisions and each division shall consist of multiple laboratories to effectively perform organized education and research.

- (1) Division of Information Science
- (2) Division of Biological Science
- (3) Division of Materials Science

Article 4 (Laboratories)

1. Graduate school shall establish laboratories to undertake educational research concerning specific areas of specialization.
2. In the graduate school a professor or associate professor shall be appointed to manage each laboratory.
3. Necessary measures concerning the laboratories shall be separately stipulated

Supplementary provisions
(Effective date)

1. These Regulations shall come into effect on April 1, 2011.

(Thus repealing the Regulations concerning Academic Sections of Nara Institute of Science and Technology)

(Repealing Measures)

2. The Regulations concerning Academic Sections of Nara Institute of Science and Technology shall be repealed. (Regulations No. 11, 2014)

Supplementary provision

These Regulations shall come into effect on April 1, 2018.
